Dialogue with the market #63: Lithium price slump

- Lithium futures prices have, unexpectedly, fallen sharply in September.
- Two key factors appear to have driven the correction: Shanghai Metals Market's upward revision to reported lithium inventories and signs that China's ESS expansion is slowing.
- Until peak-season demand and a lithium-price recovery are confirmed, we recommend maintaining a cautious stance.

WHAT'S THE STORY?

Introduction: In this issue of our *Dialogue with the market* series, we examine September's unexpected lithium price correction and its implications. Lithium futures rallied in August on expectations of sustained demand—particularly from China's ESS sector—amid low inventories and delayed restarts at key mining operations. This optimism also fueled a rally in Korean rechargeable battery stocks. The sharp reversal in September was therefore unexpected and warrants a closer look at the sector's investment outlook.

September's unexpected lithium futures correction: After rebounding in August, lithium carbonate futures fell around 16%, from CNY160,000 per tonne on Sep 2 to CNY134,000 per tonne by Sep 14. By contrast, Komis-reported prices fell just 3% over the same period. China accounts for 60-70% of global lithium demand and is the world's largest importer and refining hub, meaning domestic price movements have a strong bearing on cost, insurance, and freight prices in overseas markets. Volatility in SunSirs futures, which track China's domestic prices, therefore warrants close attention.

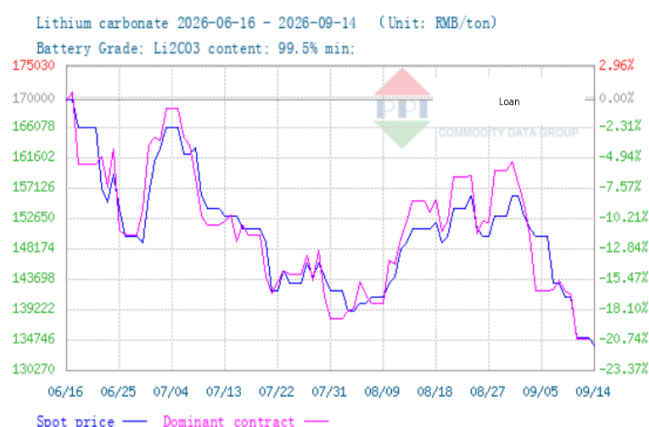

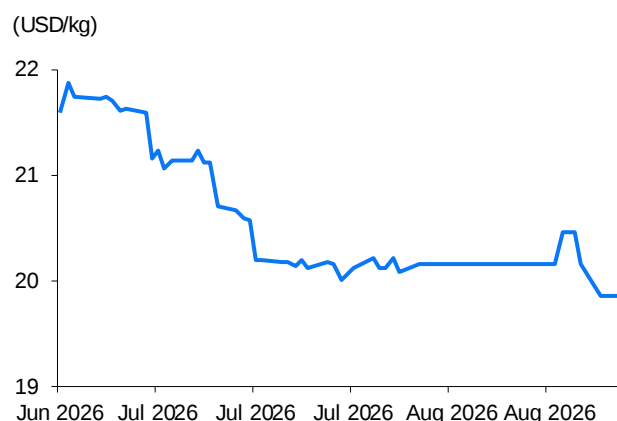
Two factors appear to have driven this month's correction. First, Shanghai Metals Market (SMM), a leading global evaluator of non-ferrous metals and battery materials, revised its lithium inventory methodology on Sep 3, resulting in an abrupt 90,000- to 100,000-tonne increase in reported inventories. Second, reports have emerged of a slowdown in China's ESS expansion plans, alongside unconfirmed reports that CATL has scaled back its September production targets.

Background (1)—SMM's inventory revision a statistical change, not a supply shock: On Sep 3, SMM announced a revision to its weekly lithium carbonate inventory methodology, effective Sep 4. The revised methodology expanded the scope of reported inventories to include previously excluded sources, including downstream traders, cell manufacturers, lithium extracted from bauxite slag, tungsten ore byproducts, and spent electrolytic aluminum residues. As a result, reported weekly inventories jumped from 70,000 tonnes to 169,000 tonnes. While this was a statistical change rather than an actual supply increase, the abrupt revision triggered a shift in market sentiment. With lithium futures having climbed to CNY160,000 per tonne in early September following the sharp August rally, the higher inventory figures provided bearish traders with a catalyst to initiate or add to short positions.

Background (2)—ESS expansion slowdown and CATL production rumors: On Sep 11, the Shanghai Securities News reported that Chinese authorities were delaying or suspending approvals for new ESS battery projects still in the planning stage, while projects already approved or under construction remained unaffected. The move follows warnings to manufacturers earlier this year over potential overcapacity.

Separately, unconfirmed local reports suggested that CATL had cut its September production targets by 5%. This reinforced concerns over weakening demand, although CATL has not officially confirmed the adjustment and no other major Chinese battery makers have reported similar cuts.

Key implications for Korea's rechargeable battery industry—Near-term share-price pressure from lithium volatility: Investors had expected lithium prices to establish a firmer trend in 2H, supported by sustained inventory drawdowns¹ and a seasonal improvement in demand. September's sharp decline in lithium futures prices has instead heightened investor unease. However, recent feedback from key producers Gangfeng Lithium and Tianqi Lithium suggests that seasonal demand is materializing, with order books remaining tight. This indicates that the factors behind the recent futures correction—including speculative positioning and short-term trading—do not yet point to a fundamental weakening in underlying lithium demand.

For now, market participants are closely watching for whether a futures price rebound can restore investor sentiment, and whether actual lithium demand remains robust during the traditional September-October peak season. At this time, Korea's rechargeable battery industry faces an additional headwind from won appreciation against the US dollar, which could weigh on earnings. Given these twin pressures, we recommend maintaining a cautious near-term stance, as share prices are likely to remain subdued until lithium prices stabilize and peak-season demand is confirmed.
